Caution



Important safety information:

- Working on motorcycles poses a safety risk. Some work may only be carried out by appropriately

1 Preparation

Attention: The original bar-end mirrors cannot be used.

- Read the safety instructions and the assembly instructions completely and carefully.
- During the subsequent work, an unsafely positioned motorcycle can fall over. Therefore, make sure that the motorcycle is on firm, straight ground and is secured against falling over and rolling away.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area.
- Protect disassembled components from damage.
- When disassembling individual parts, pay attention to the screws with which they are attached. Keep these components and screws and, unless otherwise indicated, reuse them accordingly during assembly

3 Assembly



Remove the original mirrors and handlebar ends.



Slide the new mirrors (clamp \emptyset 22 mm) onto the handlebar ends and mount them to the handlebars with the enclosed screws.

Then align and attach the mirrors.

Press the plastic lid onto the screw.



Caution: Make sure there is sufficient space between the mirror and the other parts (also with maximum steering angle).

4 Final check

After completing the work, check that all components and screws are tight and functioning correctly. Also
check the wheel's freewheel and the functionality of the brake system. Afterwards, a test drive must be
done! After completing the test drive, the tightness of all screw connections must be checked, as well as the
adequate freedom of access of all moving parts.
