Caution



Important safety advice:

- Working on motorcycles poses a safety risk. Some work may only be carried out by appropriately

1 Preparation

- Please read the entire safety information and installation manual carefully.
- A motorcycle not securely positioned can fall over during the following work. Therefore, make sure the motorbike is positioned on solid, flat ground and is secured against falling over and rolling away.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area.
- Protect removed parts from damage.
- Please note when disassembling individual parts which screws are used to fasten them. Keep these parts and screws and unless specified otherwise, reuse when assembling.

- The bar end mirrors can be used on both sides and must be modified, if required.
- The bar end mirrors are suitable for most aluminium and steel handlebars with an outside diameter of 7/8" (22mm) and 1" (25.4mm).
- The bar end mirrors must be clamped onto the handlebar over their entire width (12mm).
- Important: Make sure that nothing gets onto these clamp surfaces which decreases friction (e.g. oil, silicone, care products, etc.).

3 Installation: Handlebar end mirrors



Screw the mirror and the washer provided into the supporting arm and tighten.



Slide on the mirror (with or without adapter depending on the handlebar diameter) onto the handlebar or the handlebar extension.



Align the supporting arm and the mirror to the driver and the vehicle.

Caution: Ensure freedom of movement of throttle!
Before the final fixing, make sure that the mirror does not touch any other parts (e.g. fairing or tank), even in maximum steering angle.



Tighten the clamp screw on the supporting arm.

Tightening torque 5 Nm

Note: To clean the mirrors, use only soft cloths and suitable cleaning agents!

4 Final check

After completing the work, check that all components and screws are tight and functioning correctly.
 Afterwards, a test drive must be done! After completing the test drive, the tightness of all screw connections must be checked, as well as the adequate freedom of access of all moving parts.
